




## Germantown ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in new housing production.



# Townhouses are the predominant housing type in Germantown.




# Almost two-thirds of approved housing units are multi-family.

# Most housing sells for slightly less than County median prices.


Used single-family homes in Germantown are the exception, selling at 9.4 percent *above* the County median.



### The cost of renting in Germantown is close to the County average.




# Housing affordability rates are in line with County averages.

Percent of households in Germantown and Montgomery County where monthly housing costs exceed 30% of median household income





## Office jobs are likely to supply most future job growth in Germantown.






## Jobs are expected to exceed housing capacity in Germantown by 2015.
