Dear Ms. Saville,

Please excuse the informality of this communication. We write to express concern about the above referenced application for a 155' cell tower on rural rustic Wasche Road in the nationally recognized Ag Reserve.

The placement of the tower, in clear viewshed of the roadway and neighboring historic properties presents conflict with the Master Plan. We respectfully ask that the tower be associated with existing buildings on the site and within mature tree stands to minimize the view from roadway and neighboring properties. I will send several photos taken of the balloon test, though I understand that the applicant proposes to move the tower 20 feet or so. That change should not affect the view witnessed in these photos to any great degree and thus our concern remains.

We will follow up with communication to the hearing examiner, Tower Committee, with copy to applicant.
