A periodic update by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

SILVERPLACE BULLETIN

PROJECT HISTORY

1998: Commission acquires the parking lot next to the M-NCPPC's Park and Planning headquarters from the county in a land swap for the former Silver Spring Armory site.

2003: Commission approves the "Consolidated Headquarters Study," which justifies the need for the new headquarters. The study determined that a minimum 30% affordable / workforce housing would be required and that a public / private partnership allowing mixed-use development of the MRO site was the best way to meet the agency's multiple goals.

2004: The County Council appropriates \$850,000 in the Capital Budget to fund planning studies and the developer selection process.

2005: M-NCPPC issues a request for qualifications (RFQ) for SilverPlace. A multi-agency evaluation committee chooses three of seven development teams that responded as worthy of further consideration. M-NCPPC issues a request for proposals (RFP) to the three finalist teams in June 2006.

January 2007: Planning Board approves the recommendations of a multi-agency evaluation committee to choose a development partner: SilverPlace, LLC (Bozzuto, Spaulding and Slye Investments, and Harrison Development).

February 2007: Park and Planning staff briefs the County Council on SilverPlace.

WHAT IS SILVERPLACE?

A model, mixed-use development featuring a new headquarters for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission's Montgomery County staff — while fostering smart growth, a variety of housing and retail options, and environmentally sensitive design within Silver Spring's central business district. The project will:

- Replace the overcrowded, inefficient Park and Planning headquarters and consolidate staff from several locations.
- Provide a mix of housing options, including condos and rental apartments.
 - *Promote* smart growth with a forwardthinking urban design that's compatible with the neighborhood and an eightminute walk from the proposed Silver Spring Transit Center.

 Lower the public cost through a public / private partnership allowing M-NCPPC to use the value of the land to finance a portion of the project.

FUTURE STEPS

- On July 5, the Planning Board will review a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with SilverPlace, LLC, as well as a request for preliminary design funding. The MOU will clarify parameters of the project. The public is welcome to attend the Board meeting.
- On July 10, M-NCPPC and SilverPlace, LLC, will host a community meeting about the project. Join us!
- This summer, M-NCPPC will seek a design appropriation from the County Council to provide funding for the initial design phase of the project.

- Following a design appropriation, M-NCPPC and SilverPlace, LLC will begin site surveys, and environmental and traffic studies.
- Several months after the design phase begins, the team will submit a project plan to the Planning Board for review during public hearings.
- Throughout the review process, the SilverPlace team will host more public meetings where the project architects, traffic engineers and landscape architects will respond to questions from the community.
- After the Board approves the preliminary design and project plan, the team will seek a County Council appropriation for final design and construction.
