

### **FORWARD**

This land use coding manual is designed to assist the Maryland State Supervisor of Assessments and the Montgomery County Planning Department in identifying properties in Montgomery County by land use codes. This second edition improves the accuracy of describing land use activity by adding new land use codes. These improvements will facilitate data requests via the Planning Department's Property and Land Use Information Subsystem, which relies on property information provided by the State Tax Assessor. Therefore, the coding manual is a joint effort. The end result is an improved system to better analyze and assess the existing character of land in Montgomery County.

The coding manual identifies eleven major land use categories, as follows:

- HOUSING UNITS
- GROUP QUARTERS
- INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION
- TRANSPORTATION COMMUNICATION AND UTILITIES (Non-office)
- WAREHOUSING AND WHOLESALE (Business Oriented Activity)
- RETAIL TRADE
- OFFICE BUILDINGS AND SELECTED SERVICES
- GOVERNMENT SERVICES AND INSTITUTIONAL
- CULTURE AND RECREATION
- RESOURCE PRODUCTION
- VACANT LAND

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Each major land use category contains a series of three-digit codes that describes each type of land activity and its primary use. Conceptually, land use activity identifies the different characteristics that describe a parcel of land, its structure, or activities within the structure. Subsequently, this land use classification allows for data collection that can be regrouped into a variety of land use patterns to fit the needs of the Planning Department and the general public.

Our goal is to have a minimum number of land use codes and yet provide sufficient flexibility to distinguish between major land use types. However, codes are from time to time changed to define, more accurately, land uses in the County. ### VACANT LAND

#### Code

  (Do not include active farms or community association land, right-of-way, etc.)
- 930 Water Areas
- Other Undeveloped Land (includes land <u>not</u> available for development <u>except</u> community association and recreation land, use 740, and includes out parcels). Note: if a single-family residence is associated with more than one lot, code non-buildable lots with 990 (the lot which the house is located on is coded 111). Extra lots which are buildable should be coded 910.

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
