The lot or lots are covered by a preliminary plan of subdivision or site plan that did not receive a sediment control permit before July 1, 1991, and the preliminary plan of subdivision or site plan:
was approved before July 1, 1984, and has less than 40,000 square feet of forest cover.
OR, all of the following:
was approved or extended between July 1, 1984 and July 1, 1991, and
the construction will not result in the cutting, clearing, or grading of:
any forest in a stream buffer, or
any forest on property located in a special protection area which must submit a water quality plan.
If a preliminary or site plan approved before July 1, 1991 is being revised, the new plan will not result in the cutting of more than 5,000 additional square feet of forest.
Development or redevelopment of the property does not require resubdivision.

PLEASE NOTE: If regulated activities occur on the property other than what is being attested to, the exemption immediately terminates without action by the Planning Board. The Planning Director may require the submission and approval of a Natural Resources Inventory/Forest Stand Delineation and a Forest Conservation Plan, and may also issue a fine of up to \$1,000 per day.
