The Montgomery County Council will be holding a public hearing on the Planning Board Draft Amendment to the Master Plan for Historic Preservation: Upper Patuxent Area Historic Resources on June 12, 2012 at 1:30 p.m., at the Stella Werner Council Office Building, 100 Maryland Ave., Rockville, Maryland. If adopted as submitted, the Plan will place 29 additional properties and two districts under the jurisdiction of the Historic Preservation Commission. It would also acknowledge the Planning Board's removal of 18 properties from the Locational Atlas of Historic Sites.
