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2000 Annual Update Conclusions

- Economy is very healthy.
- Current pace of growth is rapid but manageable.
- No evidence of next downturn.
- This recovery is broad based and it appears most County residents have benefited.

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Role of Economy Study

- Supports Council's economic indicators, federal procurement initiatives.
- Collaborative effort with Departments of Finance and Economic Development.
- Assists in evaluating regulatory initiatives (e.g., Annual Growth Policy, zoning, etc.)
- Strengthens planners' understanding of market role in planning issues.

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2000 Focus



Nondepository institutions Jobs grew by almost 25%.


