For both Pennyfield Lock & Farquhar Middle school we went around the room and provided each member opinion regarding how we should respond to the applicant. In the end a vote was taken.

It was decided that we should recommend alternative #3 for the restructuring of Pennyfield Lock Bridge and that Marc Miller would draft the letter to be sent to DOT.

In the case of Farquhar Middle School, it was decided that it was not our responsibility to weigh in on the location of the school but that all care should be taken to preserve the rustic character of the road.
