Subject: Naval Ordnance Laboratory Administration Building -- Planning Board Vote

During today's Planning Board worksession on the White Oak Science Gateway, on a motion by Vice Chair Mary Wells-Harley, seconded by Commissioner Casey Anderson, with Chair Francoise Carrier, Vice Chair Mary Wells-Harley, and Commissioners Casey Anderson and Amy Presley present, and Commissioner Norman Dreyfuss absent, the Planning Board voted unanimously to:

- Add the Naval Ordnance Laboratory Administration Building (Resource 33/25-1) to the Locational Atlas (as an interim measure pending designation);
- Recommend designation of the resource on the Master Plan of Historic Preservation.

Thus, the resource is now on the Locational Atlas.

Further, the resource will be recommended for designation on the Master Plan for Historic Preservation in the White Oak Science Gateway Master Plan Planning Board Draft, which is scheduled to be transmitted to the County Council in September 2013 for the Council's consideration.

The Planning Board's vote today accorded with the recommendations of the White Oak Science Gateway Master Plan Public Hearing Draft currently before the Board. The vote also accorded with the recommendations of the Historic Preservation Commission, as well as Historic Preservation staff, per the HP staff memo attached to the staff report for today's worksession. Both the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and the White Oak Laboratory Alumni Association support adding the resource to the Atlas and recommending it for designation of the Master Plan for Historic Preservation, per testimony presented at the Planning Board public hearing.

Historic Preservation staff noted today at the Planning Board that information on the architectural and historical significance of the resource will be added to the White Oak Science Gateway Master Plan, for readers who wish to learn more about the resource than shown in the plan.
