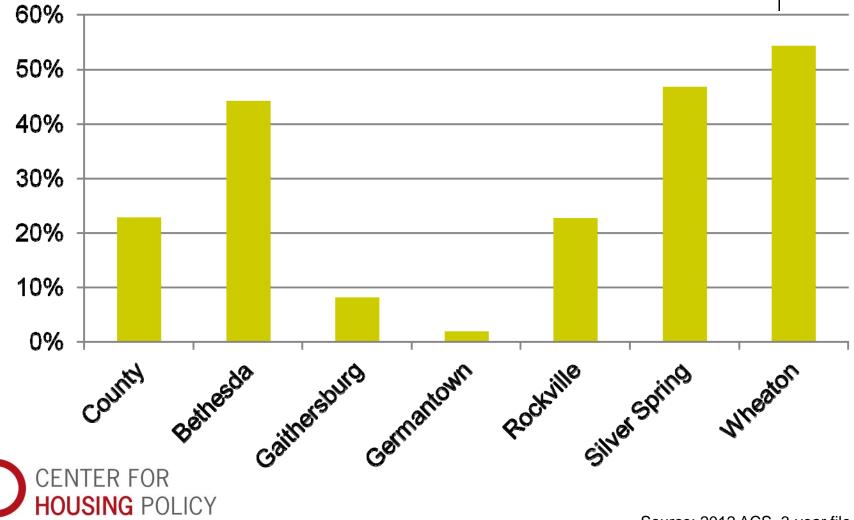
## Households Paying 30%+ of Income on Housing Costs



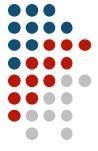


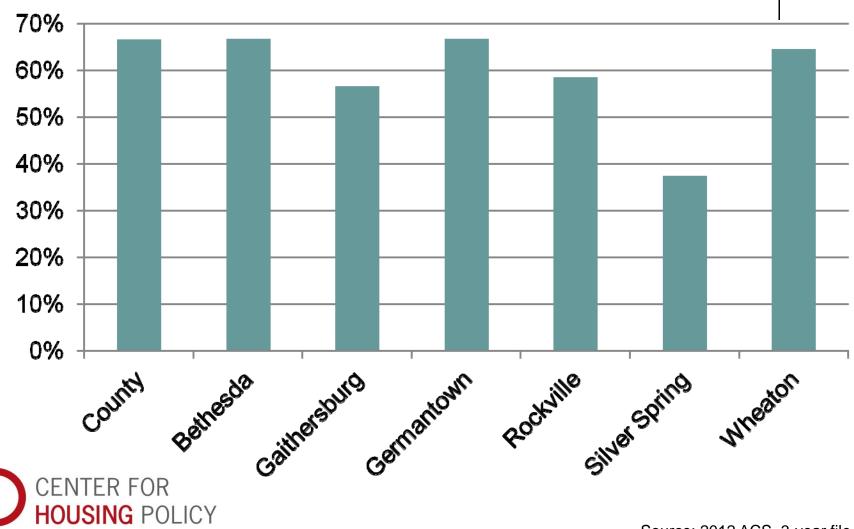
### **Housing Built Before 1960**



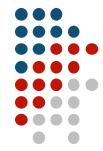


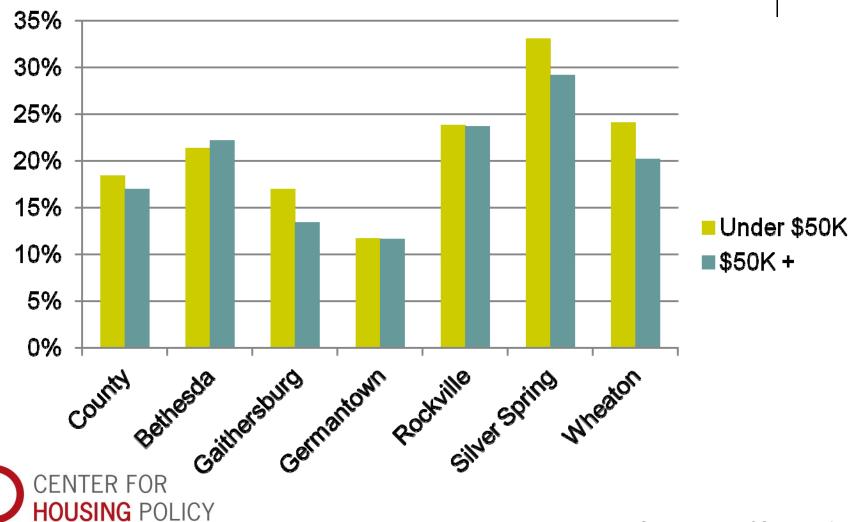
### **Homeownership Rate**

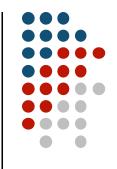




## Workers that Take Transit or Walk by Household Income



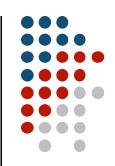

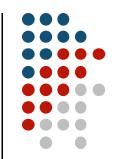

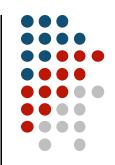

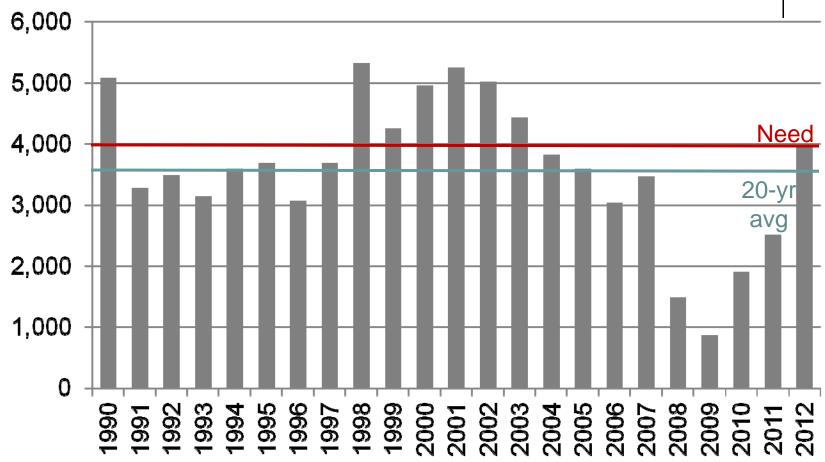

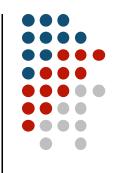
### **Building Permit Activity – Historic Rate Insufficient to Meet Future Needs**







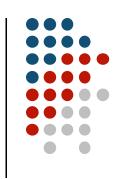
